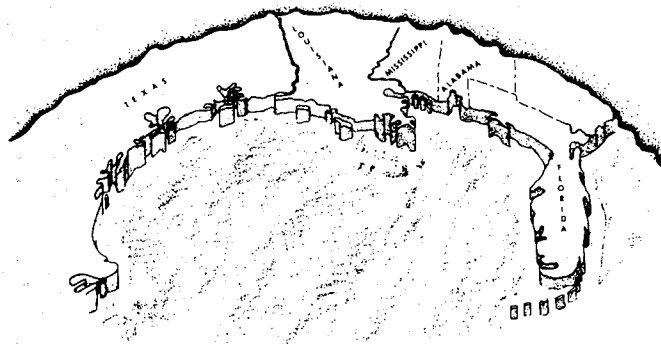

Licenses may be purchased by mail from Marine Resources Division, P.O. Box 189, Dauphin Island, AL 36528 by enclosing a money order for the license fee. There is no application form. Applicants for oyster boat, shrimp boat and menhaden licenses must include the registered vessel name or state registration number. Before selling a live bait dealer license the person's boat, truck or place of business must be inspected. Non-residents pay double the fee shown above except for shrimp boat and trawl licenses to residents of Florida, Mississippi and Louisiana (reciprocal agreement states). Licenses may be purchased at Marine Resources Division offices at Dauphin Island, Bayou La Batre and Gulf Shores.

Separate classes of vessels - pleasure and commercial - are also identified for purposes of fund distribution.

\*\*Number processed/issued by state. Amended Chapter 327.11(8)/(9) to allow County tax collectors to issue duplicate registrations/change of class registrations. The \$1 fee is retained by the County.

Commercial Vessel Means:

- a) Any resident vessel engaged in the taking of saltwater fish or saltwater products, freshwater fish or freshwater products for sale either to the consumer, retail dealer or wholesale dealer.
- b) Any vessel engaged in any activity wherein a fee is paid by the user, either directly or indirectly, to the owner, operator, or custodian of the vessel.

Non-Commercial Vessel Means: Any vessel other than a commercial vessel.

All 11 FMP District Offices have applications, however, applications must be sent directly to Tallahassee when applying for all licenses. Examples of several license applications follow.



## INSTRUCTIONS

1. PRINT or TYPE all requested information. NA = Not Applicable.
2. Enter the fee of your Saltwater Products License (SPL) and your 1984-85 SPL Number (or "applied for" if you have applied but have not received your license) in the blanks provided and deduct the SPL fee from the \$300.00 cost of this license.
3. Enter the remainder in the TOTAL ENCLOSED blank.
4. Attach your check or money order (NO CASH) for the total amount due.
5. SIGN and date the application and enter your business title, if applicable (e.g. Owner, Secretary, etc.)
6. Mail to the letterhead address.

## FEDERAL EMPLOYER'S IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 119.092, F.S., each state agency which registers or licenses corporations, partnerships, or other business entities shall include within its numbering system, the Federal Employer's Identification Number of each corporation, partnership, or other business entity registered or licensed by it. If you have no employees, the Social Security Number of the applicant is required.

## SUMMARY OF PASCO COUNTY, CSHB 984, SPECIAL ACTS 1984, LAWS OF FLORIDA

No person, firm, or corporation shall use or cause to be used any gill net from a boat in the saltwaters of Pasco County for the purpose of taking or catching fish without a valid license issued by the Department of Natural Resources.

An annual fee of \$300.00 shall be collected by the department for the issuance of the gill net license during a 60-day period beginning May 1 of each year. The license year shall begin on July 1 of each year and end on June 30 of the next succeeding year. In 1984 the 60 day license issue period shall begin August 13. Only one such license shall be required per boat when fishing upon the waters of Pasco County and shall be valid for the licensee and those members of his immediate family who are listed on this form.

Each person licensed pursuant to this Act shall prominently display the license number upon the vessel in numerals which are at least 10 inches in height and 1 inch in width in such manner that the license number is visible on both sides of the vessel. A similar number shall be displayed on the top of the vessel and be clearly visible to aircraft at all times the vessel is engaged in fishing.

This Act shall not apply to any net other than a gill net.

The license fee paid for a Saltwater Products License shall be credited against the fee paid for this gill net license.

Any similar license issued for any other Florida county shall be valid, as long as the total fee for the license is not less than \$300.00.

The violation of any provision of this Act is declared to be a criminal offense and misdemeanor within the meaning of s. 775.08, Florida Statutes, and shall be punishable as provided by law.

## DEFINITIONS

ALIEN - a person who is not a citizen of the United States, although such person may reside in Florida.

FEDERAL EMPLOYER'S ID NUMBER - this is the number used in reporting your employee's social security and withholding tax to the Internal Revenue Service, e.g. 59-0000000.

REFERENCE ATTACHMENT(S) - Department of Natural Resources printed forms which contain summaries of the Florida Statutes and/or Laws of Florida that are pertinent to the particular license/permit. They may be obtained from any Florida Marine Patrol District Office or by calling or writing to the Department of Natural Resources, Bureau of Marine Patrol Support Services & Records Management, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32303, 904/487-3122.

NON-RESIDENT - CITIZENS of the United States who have not maintained a continuous residence in Florida for a period of one year and have not actually resided in a county for a period of six months immediately preceding the application for a license.

NON-RESIDENT - FOREIGN CORPORATIONS formed in a state other than Florida even though authorized by the Secretary of State to do business in Florida.

RESIDENT or RESIDENT OF FLORIDA - CITIZENS of the United States who have continuously resided in this state, next preceding the making of their application for hunting, fishing, or other license, for the following period of time to wit: for one year in the state, and six months in the county when applied to all fish and game laws not related to freshwater fish and game.

RESIDENT - DOMESTIC CORPORATIONS formed in Florida and carried in the active files of the Secretary of State.

RETAIL SEAFOOD DEALER - any person, firm, or corporation which sells saltwater fish or other saltwater products directly to the consumer as seafood, but no license is required of a dealer in merchandise who deals in or sells only salted, cured, canned, or smoked seafood.

SALTWATER FISH - shall include all classes of pisces, shell fish, sponges, and crustacea indigenous to saltwater.

SALTWATER PRODUCTS - any species of the saltwater fish, marine plant or echinoderm, except shells, non-living sponges, and salted, cured, canned or smoked seafood.

WHOLESALE SEAFOOD DEALER - any person, firm, or corporation which sells saltwater fish or other saltwater products, excluding novelty shells and sponges, to any person, firm, or corporation except to the consumer; however, those persons so excluded shall make those reports required of such wholesale dealers.

SUMMARY OF SECTION 370.06, FLORIDA STATUTES

Every person, firm, or corporation which sells, offers for sale, barter, or exchanges for merchandise any saltwater products, including saltwater products sold for bait, must have a valid saltwater products license. Please note that this requirement does not apply to licensed wholesale or retail seafood dealers provided their activities are pursuant to said dealer licenses. However, it does apply to those persons, firms, or corporations which sell saltwater products to wholesale seafood dealers.

The cost of the Saltwater Products License will be at the full annual rate and must be renewed July 1, 1984, and every year thereafter. A Saltwater Products License may be issued in the name of an individual or a valid vessel registration or documented number. The license is not transferable. Residents must pay an annual license fee of \$25.00; Non-residents must pay an annual license fee of \$100.00; and Aliens must pay an annual license fee of \$150.00. Persons selling saltwater products for human consumption pursuant to this license may sell only to a licensed wholesale dealer. A Saltwater Products License must be presented to the licensed wholesale dealer each time saltwater products are sold for human consumption, or be in the possession of a person/vessel selling saltwater products as bait in any form. Wholesale dealers are required to keep records of each transaction in such detail as may be required by a rule to be established by the Department of Natural Resources. Persons holding a valid license or permit required by Chapter 370, F.S., to take any saltwater products shall be given credit for the amount of fee paid for such license or permit toward a Saltwater Products License. However, such credit is only valid when the license or permit for which credit is given is valid for the same year covered by the Saltwater Products License. It is unlawful for any licensed wholesale dealer to buy saltwater products from any unlicensed person, except that a licensed wholesale dealer may buy from another licensed wholesale dealer.

Any person who sells, offers for sale, barter, or exchanges for merchandise saltwater products must have a method of catch preservation which meets the requirements and standards of the seafood quality control code promulgated by the Department of Natural Resources. The Department of Natural Resources will be responsible for the issuance of these licenses. In conjunction with this licensing program, a marine fisheries information system has been established in order to gather fisheries data.

DEFINITIONS

ALIEN - a person who is not a citizen of the United States, although such person may reside in Florida.

FEDERAL EMPLOYER'S ID NUMBER - this is the number used in reporting your employee's social security and withholding tax to the Internal Revenue Service, e.g. 59-0000000.

NON-RESIDENT - CITIZENS of the United States who have not maintained a continuous residence in Florida for a period of one year and have not actually resided in a county for a period of six months immediately preceding the application for a license.

NON-RESIDENT - FOREIGN CORPORATIONS formed in a state other than Florida even though authorized by the Secretary of State to do business in Florida.

RESIDENT or RESIDENT OF FLORIDA - CITIZENS of the United States who have continuously resided in this state, next preceding the making of their application for hunting, fishing, or other license, for the following period of time to wit: for one year in the state, and six months in the county when applied to all fish and game laws not related to freshwater fish and game.

RESIDENT - DOMESTIC CORPORATIONS formed in Florida and carried in the active files of the Secretary of State.

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SALTWATER FISH - shall include all classes of pisces, shell fish, sponges, and crustacea indigenous to saltwater.

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WHOLESALE SEAFOOD DEALER - any person, firm or corporation which sells saltwater fish or other saltwater products excluding novelty shells and sponges to any person, firm or corporation except to the consumer; however, those persons so excluded shall make those reports required of such wholesale dealers.

FEDERAL EMPLOYER'S IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 119.092, F.S., each state agency which registers or licenses corporations, partnerships, or other business entities shall include within its numbering system, the Federal Employer's Identification Number of each corporation, partnership, or other business entity registered or licensed by it. All licenses issued by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department are valid only from September 1, or the issuance date, whichever occurs later, through August 31 except those which are issued for a specific number of days.

An application must be filed out before a license can be issued for Wholesale Fish Dealer, Wholesale Fish Dealer - Truck, Retail Fish Dealer - Truck, Fish Farm Vehicle, Commercial Fishing Boat - Menhaden Only or Fishing Duplicate. Shrimp House Operator and Bait Shrimp Dealer licenses are issued after an application has been completed and the applicant certifies that he does not hold certain other licenses. A completed, notarized application is required before issuance of any Commercial Bay Shrimp Boat, Non-resident Commercial Finfish Fisherman or Resident Commercial Finfish Fisherman license.
