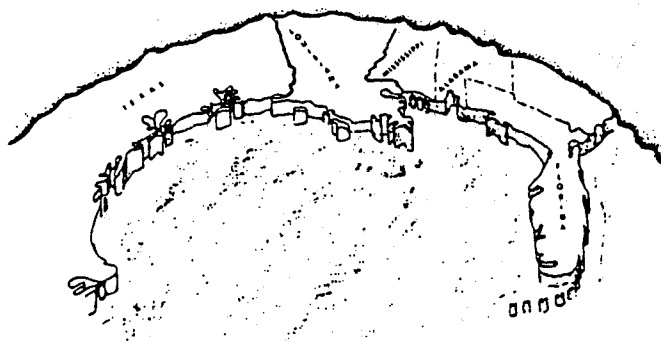

Licenses may be purchased by mail from Marine Resources Division, P.O. Box 189, Dauphin Island, AL 36528 by enclosing a money order for the license fee. There is no application form. Applicants for oyster boat, shrimp boat and menhaden licenses must include the registered vessel name or state registration number. Before selling a live bait dealer license the person's boat, truck or place of business must be inspected. Non-residents pay the same fee that is charged Alabama residents to fish in other states but no less than double the fee shown above except for shrimp boat and trawl licenses to residents of Mississippi and Louisiana (reciprocal agreement states). Licenses may be purchased at Marine Resources Division offices at Dauphin Island, Bayou La Batre and Gulf Shores.

Separate classes of vessels - pleasure and commercial - are also identified for purposes of fund distribution.

**Number processed/issued by state. Amended Chapter 327.11(8)/(9) to allow County tax collectors to issue duplicate registrations and change of class registrations and all non-profit registrations are issued by the county tax collectors. The \$1 fee is retained by the County.

Commercial Vessel Means:

- a) Any resident vessel engaged in the taking of saltwater fish or saltwater products, freshwater fish or freshwater products for sale either to the consumer, retail dealer or wholesale dealer.
- b) Any vessel engaged in any activity wherein a fee is paid by the user, either directly or indirectly, to the owner, operator, or custodian of the vessel.

Non-Commercial Vessel Means: Any vessel other than a commercial vessel.

All 11 FMP District Offices have applications, however, applications must be sent directly to Tallahassee when applying for all licenses.

You must retain a copy of this application and the receipt from a BANK MONEY ORDER or CASHIER'S CHECK to operate until you receive your original license in the mail. Allow (4) four weeks for processing.

Do not combine commercial license applications with recreational or motorboat applications.

You must complete the "RESIDENT CERTIFICATION FORM" on back and sign it before this application can be processed.

All licenses expire on December 31 unless stated otherwise.

COMMERCIAL LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

A commercial fisherman taking fish, including bait species from state waters or possessing fish in the state must purchase a: 1) Commercial Fisherman's License, 2) Gear License, 3) If fishing in saltwater, a vessel license is also required.

NOTE: Gear Licenses - Each different TYPE of gear must be licensed. You can use any legal number of each net EXCEPT oyster tongs, oyster dredge, shrimp trawls, butterfly nets and purse/menhaden seines are licensed PER net.

Transport Licenses - When applying for a transport license, you must submit the social security number or Wildlife and Fisheries identification number of the Wholesale/Retail Dealer or Commercial Fisherman you will be transporting for.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

COMMERCIAL FISHERMAN LICENSE: A person in charge of the operation of a commercial fishing vessel, whether or not that person is the owner, is required to purchase a commercial fisherman's license in his name. This license cannot be transferred to other individuals.

VESSEL LICENSES: Vessel licenses are issued in the name of the OWNER of the vessel. You must have your boat registration numbers when applying. (Required if fishing in saltwater area only).

GEAR LICENSES: A commercial fisherman must purchase a commercial gear license indicating that the applicable gear fee has been paid. Gear licenses must be licensed in the owner's name. If the owner is hiring a commercial fisherman to run his nets, he must give the social security number or Wildlife and Fisheries identification number of the commercial fisherman who will be in charge of his operations.

TRANSPORT LICENSES: Operator and drivers of any form of commercial transport, except common carriers who are in the act of loading, unloading, or transporting fish shall have in their possession one of the following: 1) A Commercial Fisherman's License, 2) A Wholesale/Retail Dealer's License, 3) A Transport License

A person transporting fish under privilege of a transport license is prohibited from buying or selling, by any means whatsoever, any species of fish. Transport licenses are freely transferable between vehicles.

WHOLESALE/RETAIL DEALER LICENSE: A person buying, acquiring, or handling, by any means whatsoever, any species of fish to Louisiana for resale, including bait species, is a wholesale/retail dealer and must purchase a wholesale/retail dealer's license. A wholesale/retail dealer shall include: 1) The owner or operator of any fish factory, platform, or other processing plant, 2) A person shipping out of or into the state.

If the licensee owns or operates more than one place of business, an additional wholesale/retail dealer's license must be purchased for each additional place of business.

★★ RESIDENT CERTIFICATION ★★

Act 388 of the 1986 Regular Session defined "Bona fide resident" and "Nonresident" as follows:

"Bona fide resident" means any person who has resided in this state **continuously during the twelve months** immediately prior to the date on which he applies for any license and who has manifested his intent to remain in this state by establishing Louisiana as his legal domicile, as demonstrated by compliance with **ALL** of the following, as applicable:

- (a) If registered to vote, he is registered to vote in Louisiana.
- (b) If licensed to drive a motor vehicle, he is in possession of a Louisiana driver's license.
- (c) If owning a motor vehicle located within Louisiana, he is in possession of a Louisiana registration for that vehicle.
- (d) If earning an income, he has filed a Louisiana state income tax return and has complied with state income tax laws and regulations.

As to a corporation or other legal entity, a resident shall be any which is incorporated or otherwise organized under and subject to the laws of Louisiana, and as to which the principal place of business and more than fifty percent of the officers, partners, or employees are domiciled in Louisiana.

"Nonresident" means any person who is not a bona fide resident as that term defined above.




